### **Equine herpesvirus myeloencephalopathy (EHM)**

Effective immediately: All horses originating from any state where Equine herpesvirus myeloencephalopathy (EHM) has been diagnosed in the last month, must be accompanied by a health certificate (certificate of veterinary inspection) and signed by an accredited veterinarian that includes the following statement:

"I have examined all the animals identified on this certificate within 72 hours of shipment date and found them to be free from signs of Equine herpesvirus myeloencephalopathy (EHM). During the last thirty (30) days, these animals have not been exposed to EHM nor located on an EHM confirmed or an EHM suspected premises."
