Re: Requirements for Poultry Exhibitions/Events

The emergency order implemented on September 1, 2015 for poultry exhibitions/events/public sales within the state of Arkansas has been rescinded effective immediately. The requirements for poultry exhibitions/events/public sales in Arkansas are as follows:

1. All poultry must be Pullorum Typhoid (PT) negative within 90 days of exhibition/public sale or originate from an NPIP PT Clean Flock with documentation (90 day certificate or NPIP Certificate).
2. Out of state poultry entering Arkansas that do not originate from an NPIP PT Clean Flock must have a negative PT test within 90 days of exhibition/public sale and a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
